Writing & Reading: This term, we will be reading *The Boy at the Back of the Class* by Onjali Q. Rauf. The story follows a young refugee named Ahmet, told through the perspective of his classmates, as they learn about kindness, friendship, and empathy while trying to help him reunite with his family.

In writing, we will focus on poetry, using *Carry Me Away* by Matt Goodfellow as inspiration. Pupils will explore a range of poetic forms, including rhyming poems, kennings, acrostic poems, and limericks, and will have opportunities to write and perform their own creative pieces.

Maths: In maths, we will be developing our multiplication and division skills, with a particular focus on multiplying two-digit numbers by one-digit numbers.

Project Based Learning: Our project-based learning will focus on Design and Technology. Pupils will design, make, and evaluate their own smoothies and wraps, developing practical skills and understanding of food preparation.

PSHE: In PSHE, we will explore autonomy and advocacy, including rights, responsibilities, and consent. Later in the term, we will move on to learning about choices and influences.

Offsite Study: As part of our wider curriculum, we will be visiting Drakes Farm in Crockernwell. This experience will support the development of social skills, as well as pupils' SEMH and EHCP targets.

Forest School: we will be minibeast hunting in our woodland areas or our newly refurbished pond. We'll cook some new recipes on camping stoves or over the firepit. Den building progresses as students are enjoying constructing their own spaces!

Music: we're thinking about performances for our end of term talent show and / or developing production skills by composing music for the school disco!

Cooking & Nutrition: we're building on our skills by cooking healthy & delicious snacks together in the kitchen.

PE: Summer means Athletics, so we will be developing our running & jumping skills this term!
